

COURSE INFORMATION – CPP30411 Certificate III in Security OperationAustralian Academic Solutions

Please note:

On 21 January 2019, the training course for Security Officers was updated. The new course CPP31318 Certificate III in Security Operations supersedes and is not equivalent to the previous course CPP30411 Certificate III in Security Operations.

On 18 December 2019, Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) Commissioners agreed to extend the transition period of the CPP30411 Certificate III in Security Operations and CPP20212 Certificate II in Security Operations for learner cohorts in NSW, ACT, Tasmania and Victoria until 1 July 2020.

LRD (Licensing and Regulation Division of the Victoria Police) will continue to accept the CPP30411 when applying for a Private Security Individual Licence with the activity of Bodyguard until advised otherwise.

Code & Title:	CPP30411 Certificate III in Security Operations				
Course Description	This course is designed for persons who have already completed other entry level studies relevant to the security industry, as well for entry level into specialised streams the security industry which comprises of people and companies mainly engaged in providing security, protection and private enquiry services - other than units of police forces and government security agencies. This qualification is suitable for individuals who wish to deepen and broaden their skills and knowledge in security operations and lead security teams in the field. It provides a pathway to further learning and work in various security roles and settings, including security risk management.				
Delivery Mode	This program is delivered in a classroom-based face to face environment that includes simulated workplace environments.				
Course Duration	The 14 units required for the CPP30411 are delivered and assessed over 14 days duration of full time study at 40 hours per week, 8.30am – 5.00pm - including half an hour break at midday. It is to be remembered that where students have already completed units from this course in the CPP20212 Certificate II in Security Operations direct credit should be granted and students cannot be asked to repeat the units again. A common scenario for this will be for students who have completed the 19 units within the CPP07 Training Package that make up the licence categories of Combined Unarmed Guard & Crowd Control. Where these units have been completed it would be expected that credit could be granted for all units covered on days 9,10,11,12,13,14 and as listed below; • CPPSEC3005A Prepare and present security documentation and reports • CPPSEC3017A Plan and conduct evacuation of premises • CPPSEC3002A Manage conflict through negotiation • CPPSEC3013A Control persons using empty hand techniques • CPPSEC3013A Control persons using empty hand techniques • HLTFA311A Apply first aid Therefore the student who has completed the CPP20212 (CC&UG) would only be required to complete 8 days of full time training for the 8 units minus the 6 units listed above.

Competent in written and spoken English: The Licensing and Regulation Division (LRD) requires that all learners seeking enrolment into this qualification have an appropriate level of written and spoken English suitable for employment within the private security industry. These skills are assessed by way of a Pre- Training Review prior to the enrolment process. The security industry regulators anticipate that qualified individuals will have a basic level of English proficiency to clearly communicate with emergency services, team members and the general population whilst undertaking the role. During enrolment, prior to course commencement, students must participate in a Pre - Training Review session to determine their current competencies, suitability and appropriateness for this qualification.					
Course Outcomes	Employment Pathway At the Certificate III level a person is equipped with skills and knowledge to perform supervision duties. This would include leadership skills to develop work teams. A security supervisor may also have the responsibility of managing a work team and this course will deliver competencies in line with this role.
