



HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide an advanced first aid response, including management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

This unit applies to workers who may be required to provide, coordinate and manage a first aid response across a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings.

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will have the skills and knowledge to perform emergency first aid procedures in the first few minutes after a life threatening incident.

Blended delivery mode:

Pre-course study – the Learner Guide is emailed to the learner as a pdf document one week prior to attending the face to face class training of supervised instruction.

The learner is then required to attend a class of training and assessment involving practical demonstrations.

Course duration – Class delivery and times:

The duration of the course is delivered and assessed over two (2) days of face to face class training and assessment.
9.00am to 5.30pm with a half an hour lunch break.

Entry requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for persons seeking enrolment into this qualification.

Competent in written and spoken English

Students are required to be competent in written and spoken English to gain entry to the course. A Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Assessment is a mandatory requirement prior to enrolment. Oral communication is very important in order to make an accurate verbal report to emergency response services and workplace supervisor.

Physical requirements:

It is important to note that HLTAID competency standards do require a level of physical ability to meet the evidence requirements for assessment. These standards relate to the level of performance required to provide resuscitation and respond to an emergency situation where there may be risk to life.

It is a Training Package requirement of this course that you are physically capable of performing uninterrupted CPR for at least 2 minutes on an adult manikin situated on the floor, a further 2 minutes on an infant manikin on a firm surface and a further 2 minutes of Bag-valve-mask ventilation and 2 minutes of compression during a 2 rescuer procedure on an adult manikin on the floor.

Course Structure

Theory—Knowledge—you will learn and be assessed on the following:

- o State/Territory regulations, first aid codes of practice and workplace procedures
- o Legal, workplace and community considerations
- o Considerations when providing first aid
- o Principles and procedures for first aid management of Scenarios which also include complications that can arise
- o Basic anatomy and physiology

Practical demonstrations—Skills—you will be assessed responding to first aid scenarios in a simulated workplace environment and expected to perform demonstrations on the tasks provided:

- Follow DRSABCD in line with ARC guidelines, including:
 - o perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) (5 cycles of both compressions and ventilations) on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor
 - o perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescuer CPR (5 cycles both compressions and ventilations) on an infant resuscitation manikin placed on a firm surface
 - o perform at least 2 minutes of Bag-valve-mask ventilation and at least 2 minutes of compression during a two rescuer procedure on an adult resuscitation manikin placed on the floor
 - o respond appropriately in the event of regurgitation or vomiting
 - o manage the unconscious breathing casualty
 - o follow the prompts of a Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
 - o follow single rescue procedure, including the demonstration of a rotation of operators with minimal interruptions to compressions
- Respond to at least three simulated first aid scenarios contextualised to the candidate's workplace/community setting, including:
 - o demonstrate safe manual handling techniques
 - o conduct a visual and verbal secondary survey assessment of the casualty
 - o assess vital signs (respirations, pulse and temperature)
 - o communicate effectively with a first aid team providing direction and coordination of other first aiders
 - o post-incident debrief and evaluation
 - o provide an accurate verbal and written report of the incident
- Apply first aid procedures:
- Locate and interpreted workplace policies and procedures
